SUMMERTIME FUN

Children, particularly those who have experienced trauma, can become especially unpleasant if close attention isn't paid to meeting their needs. Here are some tips to help your child (and you) have a wonderful summer:

After months of having to stay indoors, summer provides the perfect opportunity for activity. Make sure that your child is getting plenty of chances to burn off excess energy. Swimming at the beach and relays in the yard are easy, fun, and free! Lots of activity is important every day and your local Post-Adoption Resource Center has some awesome opportunities for you and your family to stay active this summer. Don't forget the water! Warm weather can quickly dehydrate your child. To help encourage getting plenty of fluids, try a fun-looking water bottle and flavor water naturally with fruit. For kids who would rather have juice, try diluting it with water.

There are so many fresh, healthy snacks available in the summer. Make sure that your child is getting plenty of healthy snacks throughout the day. If your child is not generally a fan of healthy fare, get him or her involved! Try strawberry picking or plant a small vegetable garden.

BOLD ADVENTURE, SUCCESSFUL EXPERIENCES

B.A.S.E. Camp is a seven-day camp experience for pre-teens for early intervention. This program is for youth beginning to have difficulty managing their anger and emotions, struggling to transition into a place of personal responsibility, and lacking respect for others. Camp site is at Eagle Village.

The cost is \$750 per child with scholarship applications available.

PROJECT SURVIVE

July 7-16 & July 21-30

Ages 13-17

Project Survive is a 10-day, intensive wilderness experience for adolescent youth. Teens who are firsttime offenders, struggle behaviorally at school and in the community or who may be in need of additional support services would be ideal participants. Camp sites are off-campus. The cost is \$1,500 per child with scholarship applications available.




How to Take the Grrrr Out of Anger
